Job Description:

Working with the YMCA of Klamath Falls (YMCA) and Klamath Falls City School District (KFCD), this position will be concerned with all duties necessary to implement a physical education-based curriculum. This is a seasonal position which will run from September-June.

Job Functions:

- Implement the SPARK program curriculum as instructed by supervisor.
- Provide, up to 30-minute sessions physical education lessons, appropriate for each grade level as directed by the YMCA.
- Provide a positive, well-organized, and disciplined environment to promote student learning and development of essential physical education skills and fitness practices.
- Develop character education as a part of class operation.
- Attend and actively participate in staff meetings, trainings and any other meetings assigned by supervisor.
- Maintain professional relationships with school personnel, students, families, and community partners.
- Consistently demonstrate professional work habits.
- All paperwork is completed professionally and within given timelines.
- Consistently works to enhance level of job knowledge.
- Upholds all ethical polices to which the agency subscribes.
- Upholds policies specific to school district policies and expectations.
- Carries out other tasks assigned by supervisor.
- Student supervision responsibilities as deemed appropriate by YMCA SPARK Program and school site principal.
- Will meet all district requirements for criminal background checks.
- At all times will wear district-provided identification badge while on school premises.
- Works well individually and in a team environment.
- Personal goals and values that emulate the YMCA core values and support the YMCA mission statement.

Qualifications:

- Experience in working with children in an educational or recreational setting-required
- CPR, First Aid, AED certifications and Child Abuse prevention training within 30 days of hire date.
- Previous experience working with children in a developmental setting preferred.
- Ability to plan, organize and implement age-appropriate/developmentally appropriate program activities.
- Previous experience with diverse populations, which includes, but not limited to, working with students with behavioral issues. Ability to develop positive, authentic relationships with people from different backgrounds.
